## **Annual Honey Show**

Notes for Competitors

Entries will be received into the following classes

1. **Extraction Frame** - note this will be from a 9" frame or less honey box with capping available for hot knife. Plastic frames acceptable.
  - A. Full Depth
  - B.  $\frac{3}{4}$  Frame
  - C.  $\frac{1}{2}$  FrameNote – One Frame per person
2. **Honey Frame** – suitable for cutting into comb sections.
  - A. Full Depth
  - B.  $\frac{3}{4}$  Frame
  - C.  $\frac{1}{2}$  FrameNote – One Frame per person
3. **Dark Honey Granulated.**
4. **Dark Honey Liquid.** Strait from the hive. Hint - place your entries into the deep freeze and remove say two days prior to the show.
5. **Medium Honey Granulated.**
6. **Medium Honey Liquid.**
7. **Light Honey Granulated.**
8. **Light Honey Liquid.**
9. **Wooden Frames and Ross Rounds** – also called box honey sections and Ross Rounds. Contains capped honey comb.
10. **Cut Comb Honey** – Boxed in a white container with clear plastic lid.
11. **Wax Block** – To weigh as near to 500gms as possible

### **Non Trophy Entries**

12. **Novelty Wax** - crafted and can include novelty items, to appeal to the judge's eye.
13. **Honey based product** –appealing to one of four senses – sight, taste, touch and smell.
